Announcing the Ray Cramer Scholarship

To be given to a graduating senior member of the 2019 All-State Bands.

The Indiana Bandmasters Association has established a \$1000 scholarship to be given during the All-State Band Weekend to a graduating senior member of one of the bands. To be eligible the student must be a member in good standing of his/her High School Band and a member of the 2019 All-State Band or 2019 All-State Honor Band. The student should be planning a career in music and be planning to start a degree program as a music major in the fall of 2019. Completed applications will only be accepted at the onsite registration 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM Friday, March 8, 2019.

Accompanying this application should be an Official Transcript, the Student Essay described within and three letters of recommendation. One recommendation must be from the student's current band director, a second from another music teacher familiar with the student and one from a person not directly connected to music. Any application incomplete in any way will be rejected.
