Mr. Beeler is a member of the American Bandmasters Association, College Band Directors National Association, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Pi Kappa Lambda, and Executive Board of the New York State School Music Association.

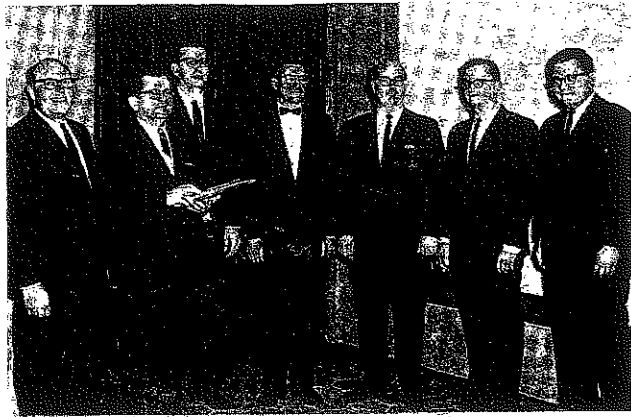
