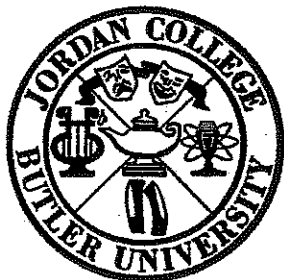

Professor Jack O. Evans is Director of the Buckeye Scarlet Band at the Ohio State University, Columbus, Ohio. He is currently Head of the Brass Instrument Department in the School of Music and from 1952-1963 was the director of the nationally famous Ohio State University Marching Band.

He is well known in Indiana and the Mid-West as a guest conductor, brass clinician and adjudicator. In 1967 he was appointed Director of the All-Ohio Boys Band and the All-Ohio Youth Symphony at the Ohio State Fair.

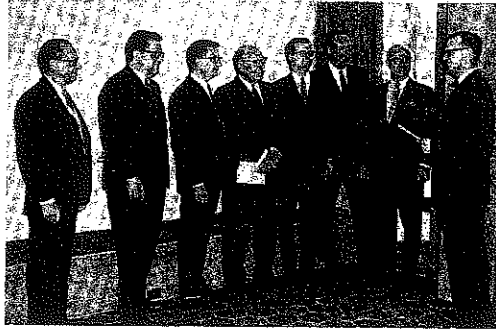
