The Conductor

Lt. Col. Dale Harpham was director of the world famous United States Marine Band in Washington, D. C. from April 18, 1972 until his retirement as director November 1, 1974. Prior to that he was assistant director for seventeen years. Previously he served more than twenty years as the band's solo trombonist, cellist, vocalist, narrator, script writer, dance band leader and conductor of special ensembles.

In 1973 The School Musician Magazine named Lt. Col. Harpham one of the ten most outstanding music directors in the United States.

A native of Pleasant Lake, Indiana, Lt. Col. Harpham has returned to Indiana the past two summers to direct the concert band at the Smith-Walbridge Band Camp.

He is an active member of the American Bandmasters Association and served as Chairman of the ABA Research Center. Other honors include Music Director of the famed Gridiron Club, Director de Musica of the Military Order of the Carabao, and Director of the Alfalfa Club. He is a noted guest conductor for high school, collegiate, and professional bands.
