## The Conductor

CHRISTOPHER IZZO, Chairman, Department of Music and formerly Director of the Western Illinois University Wind Ensemble, which has won national and international recognition, received a B.S. and M.S. in Music Education from Ithaca College and received a woodwind performance diploma from the Juilliard School of Music.

Named as "Outstanding Educator in America" in 1973 and 1975, Mr. Izzo also received the Illinois Office of Education's "Special Commendation" for outstanding contributions to Music Education in Illinois, and was also the first Illinois recipient of the National Band Association's "Citation for Excellence."

His organizations have received national acclaim and have performed for the North Central Regional M.E.N.C., C.B.D.N.A. National Conference, many state and regional conferences, the most recent performance being at the National M.E.N.C. in Atlantic City and a program at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts.

The Indiana Bandmasters Association is proud to have Christopher Izzo as guest conductor of the Indiana All-State High School Band of 1977.
