The Conductors

Stephen E. Squires brings a wealth of experience and talent to the Indiana All-State Band. He is highly sought after as a conductor, educator, pianist, and trumpet artist. An Assistant Professor of Music at Northern Illinois University, he conducts the award-winning Wind Ensemble and Chamber Winds, the Wind Symphony, and has conducted the University Chorus. His Wind Ensemble was selected this year to perform at the national convention of the College Band Directors National Association. This ensemble has won the first place "Best Collegiate Symphonic Band" award from *Downbeat* magazine every year except one.

Mr. Squires received his musical training at the Eastman School of Music and the Crane School of Music in New York, with continued study at California State University at Northridge in Los Angeles. Formerly a faculty member at Plymouth State College of the University of New Hampshire and conductor of the Lakes Region Orchestra, he joined the faculty of NIU in 1982 as a member of the conducting staff and instructor of trumpet. Mr. Squires also serves as Music Director and Conductor of one of Chicago's finest professional chamber orchestras, the Illinois Chamber Symphony.

Richard Suddendorf is a Professor of Music at Western Michigan University, where he serves as Director of Bands. He joined the WMU music faculty in the fall of 1979 after teaching 14 years at Ohio State University, where he served as trumpet professor, director of the faculty brass quintet, and associate conductor of the Ohio State Concert Band. During his nine-year tenure at Capital University in Columbus, Ohio, Suddendorf served as Instrumental Department Coordinator and conductor of the Symphonic Wind Ensemble, University Concert Bands, and University Symphony Orchestra.

Suddendorf received his bachelor's degree in music education from the University of Cincinnati's Conservatory of Music, where he also earned a certificate in trumpet. He received his master's degree in music education from the University of Illinois.

Among his numerous professional honors and awards, Suddendorf received Distinguished Teaching Awards from Ohio State University and Capital University. In 1975, he was elected to the prestigious American Bandmasters Association in New Orleans. He served as President of the Mid-American Conference Band Directors Association from 1982-1984, and in March, 1984, he received the Citation of Excellence Award from the National Band Association.

Often called upon to serve as guest conductor for band festivals, Suddendorf was selected as guest conductor for the All-State Band which performed at the 1978 OMEA Convention in Dayton, Ohio; the All-State Honors Band at Okemos, Michigan; and other festivals throughout the United States.

Suddendorf's professional affiliations include Phi Mu Alpha professional music fraternity, and the National Band Association. He is a member of several music honoraries, including Phi Beta Mu, Pi Kappa Lambda, and Kappa Kappa Psi.
