The Conductors

Richard K. Hansen is Associate Professor of Music and Director of Bands at St. Cloud State University, where he conducts the Wind Band and guides all aspects of the University Band program. Mr. Hansen designed the recently approved Master of Moste degree in Conducting at St. Cloud State University. He teaches graduate and undergraduate courses in conducting, history of wind hand literature, American music, and music education.

Professor Hansen has presented papers and articles on American wind music for the College Band Directors National Association, the International Society for the Research and Promotion of Wind Band Music, and the Minnesota Music Educators Association. He is currently President for the Minnesota Chapter of the College Band Directors National Association. Mr. Hansen has guest conducted for over 150 high school

and college/university band festivals in the upper midwest.

Prior to his position of St. Cloud State University, Mr. Hansen was the Director of Instrumental Mosic at Hawley, Minnesota. He holds a B.A. degree in Music Education from Sioux Falls Cullege, a M.A. degree in musicology from the University of Minnesota, and is presently pursuing a Ph.D. in music at the University of Minnesota.

Timothy Mahr is an Associate Professor of Music and Director of Bands at the University of Minnesota - Duloth, where he conducts the UMD symphonic Wind ensemble, concert Band, and various brass ensembles. In addition, he teaches applied low brass, composition, courses in wind band literature and history, conducting, music education, and supervises instrumental student teaching. He is also the founder and conductor of the community-bused Twin Ports Wind Ensemble

Mahr is betive as a guest conductor and clinician, conducting All State Bands, honor band festivals, clinics and performances of his works across the nation and in Norway and Canada. His interpretations have earned the praise of notable composers such as Gian Carlo Menolti, Warren Benson, Vincont Persichetti, Ned Rorem, and Fisher

Tull.

Mahr is well known as a composer and has over 35 serious works to his credit, eight of which have been contracted for publication. He recently received the 1991 ABA/Ostwald Award for his piece The Soaring Hawk. His works have been performed at Lincoln Contor in New York, the Midwest International Band and Orchestra Clinic, the national conventions of the American Bandmasters Association and the College Band Directors National Association, the Sixteenth Biennial Congress of the International Society for Music Education, and numerous state and regional conventions. His compositions have been and continue to be performed by the U.S. Marine Band, U.S. Air force Band, other armed service bands, major university bands, and Goldman Memorial Band, all state bands and ensembles in fifteen countries on four continents. Many of his works have been broadcast on the Manusota Public Radio network. Recordings of three of his works can be found on the Crest label.

Mahr is a graduate of St. Otaf College and received his master degree in trombone performance from the University of Iowa, where he is presently a doctoral candidate in

conducting.
