The Conductors

Timothy Topolewski

Timothy Topolewski completed a Bachelor of Music degree as a full scholarship recipient at Michigan State University, a Master of Music degree at Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C., and a Doctor of Musical Arts degree at the University of Illinois.

A native of Michigan, Dr. Topolewski has made numerous appearances as soloist and conductor both in the United States and abroad. He has performed with the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra and chamber ensembles of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra, has been featured artist on live radio broadcasts while on tour in Mexico and has appeared in recital with Metropolitan Opera soprano Kay Griffel. His principal instructor in conducting has been Harry Began at the University of Illinois. Additional studies in conducting have been taken with Herbert Blumstedt, Music Director of the Dresden Staatskapelle and San Francisco Symphony Orchestras. After serving with distinction in the U. S. Army Band in Washington, D. C., he was awarded a three-year conducting internship to work as assistant to Harry Began at the University of Illinois.

Dr. Topolewski was co-editor, with Frederick Fennell, of the newly published *Lincolnshire Posy*, "Full Score Edition" by Percy Grainger. His four-volume work entitled *Errata Studies for the Wind Band Conductor* has won critical acclaim from some of the nation's finest conductors and composers.

Gregg I. Hanson

Gregg I. Hanson is Director of Bands and Professor of Music at the University of Arizona in Tucson. Formerly, Director of Bands at the University of Utah in Salt Lake City from 1976 to 1990, Professor Hanson developed one of the premier collegiate ensembles in the nation, performing for the Music Educators National Conference twice, the American Bandmasters Association, and the College Band Directors National Association conventions.

From 1968 to 1976 he served as Director of Bands at Davis High School of Kaysville, Utah where the band achieved national recognition performing for the National MENC meeting in Anaheim, California in 1974 and literally traveling from coast to coast (California to Washington, D.C.).

Professor Hanson received degrees from the University of Michigan School of Music in the "Reveille Years" and studied conducting with Elizabeth A. H. Green and William D. Reveille. His major instrument is trumpet and his principal teachers were his mother, Fay Hanson, a widely respected clinician for Bach (deceased in 1973), and Clifford P. Lillya.

He currently serves the band profession on the boards of the National Band Association and the John Philip Sousa Foundation and has held official capacities with the College Band Directors National Association. In addition, he is in demand as a guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator throughout the United States, Canada, Mexico, and Europe and has conducted ten European concert tours since 1974.
