#### THE CONDUCTORS

#### Paula K. Holcomb

Dr. Paula K. Holcomb is an associate professor of music at Central College where she has taught since 1979. Holcomb holds her doctorate in instrumental conducting from Northwestern University where she studied under John P. Paynter. She received her bachelor's and master's of music education degrees from Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa. A student of Paul Vermel at the Aspen Music Festival, Holcomb has also studied conducting with Elizabeth Green and Sixton Ehrling.

As director of bands at Central, Holcomb conducts the Symphonic Wind Busemble, Symphonic Band and brass ensembles. In addition, Holcomb is the supervisor of adjunct faculty and teaches conducting, instrumental music education, and applied French horn.

During her tenure at Central, Holcomb has organized and conducted the Symphonic Wind Ensemble and Symphonic Band on tours throughout the U.S.A., Canada and Mexico. Under her direction, the Symphonic Wind Ensemble has presented concerts at the Iowa Music Educators Association and Iowa Bandmasters Association conferences. She recently commissioned a wind ensemble work by Dana Wilson which was premiered by the Central College Symphonic Wind Ensemble.

In addition to her work at Central, Helcomb is assistant horn with the Des Moines Symphony. She is the founder and conductor of the Des Moines Chamber Ensemble and

conductor/music director of the Central Iowa Symphony.

Past president of the Iowa Music Educators Association, Holcomb is a nationally known adjudicator, conductor-clinician, and guest conductor. She has been the guest conductor of more than 180 honor and university bands and orchestras. Holcomb's record as an adjudicator includes more than 120 high school music festivals throughout the U.S.A., Mexico and Canada.

#### Ray E, Cramer

Ray E. Cramer joined the faculty of the Indiana University School of Music in the fall of 1969. He became director of the famed Marching Hundred in the fall of 1972. In 1982, Mr. Cramer was appointed Director of Bands. Under his leadership, the Indiana University Symphonic Band has carned an international reputation for outstanding musical performances including the 1982 ABA Convention, Indianapolis; the 1984 joint American Bandmasters Association/Japan Bandmasters Association Convention, Tokyo; the 1988 MENC National Convention, Indianapolis; 1991 National CBDNA Convention in Kansas City and other regional and state conventions. In addition to his administrative responsibilities as the department chaltman, Mr. Cramer teaches courses at the graduate level in wind conducting, history and literature.

He is a member of ABA, CBDNA, NBA, WASBE, MENC, EMEA, IBA, CIDA, and is affiliated with Phi Mu Alpha, Kappa Kappa Psi, Tau Beta Sigma, Phi Kappa Delta and Phi Beta Mu. Mr. Cramer is a recipient of the Student Alumni Council Senior Faculty Award (1988), the CIDA Director of the Year Award (1988), the Phi Beta Mu, International Assembly, Outstanding Bandmaster Award (1988) and the Kappa Kappa Psi Bohumil Makovsky Memorial Award (1991), He is the past president of the College Band Directors National Association and has served as president of the Indiana Bandmasters Association, the North Central Division of CBDNA and the Big Ten Band Directors Association.

Mr. Cramer's solid musicianship, broad knowledge of traditional and contemporary wind literature and dynamic personality keeps him in constant demand as a guest conductor-clinician throughout the U.S.A. He served on the faculty of the Musashino Academia of Music Wind Ensemble in Tokyo, Japan, as a guest conductor in the Fall of 1990 and the Summer of 1992.

A native of Illinois, Mr. Cramer has degrees from Western Illinois University and the University of Iowa. In December 1991, he was presented with an Honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters from his alma mater of Western Illinois University.
