#### Lt. Col. Alan L. Bonner

Lieutenant Colonel Atan L. Bonner is the former commander and conductor of the United States Air PorceBand from Washington, D.C. His four years at the helm of the Air Fonce's premiere band culminates a 26 year career in the Air force. During his career, he led bands in Illinois, Florida, New Jersey, California, Texas, and Nebraska. In addition to directing hundreds of concetts on tours throughout the United States and abroad, Colonel Bonner led the Strategic Air Command Band on a six-nation tour of the Persian Gulf on a special mission to support our troops in the United Nations Desert Shield/Desert Storm Operation.

Originally from Idabel, Oklahoma, he is a 1969 graduate of the University of Oklahoma with a bachelor of music education degree. In 1981 he carned a master of music degree from the University of South Florida at Tampa. Colonel Bonner is also a graduate of the Squadron Officers School, Air Command and Staff College, and the Air War College. His professional affiliations include the American Bandmasters Association, Music Educators National Conference, the College Band Directors National Association, and the National Band Association.

Colonel Bonner retires from the Air Porce this spring and will assume his new position as National Executive Director of the National Honorary Read Fraternity and Sorority, Kappa Kappa Psi/Tau Beta Signia, headquartered in Stillwater, Oklahoma.

He currently resides in Alexandria, Virginia with his wife, Jennifer, and two of their three daughters, Megan and Beth Arm. Their eldest, Kelly, is a freshman at the University of Florida in Gainesville.

#### John Boyd

John Boyd is Director of Bands, Professor of Music, and Coordinator of the Wind/Percussion Division at Indiana State University. A native of Manhattan, Kansas, Dr. Boyd attended Northwestern University where he received the bachelor of music education and master of music degrees. He received the doctor of musical arts degree from the University of Missouri - Kansas City. Advanced study in conducting was done with John Paynter, Bernard Rubenstein, and Crawford Gates.

Following his graduation from Northwestern, Dr. boyd taught at Northern Illinois University where he was assistant director of bands. Since then Dr. Boyd has been Director of Bands at Wichita State University, Kent State University, and the University of Arizona. Dr. Boyd is considered to be one of the most dynamic wind conductors in the country today. During his tenure as a collegiate conductor, he has conducted performances that have been enthusiastically received at College Band Directors' regional conferences in Illinois, Texas, Ohio, and California; MENC conventions in Arizona, Ohio, Southwestern MtiNC, and the Western Collegiate Wind Festival in Presno, California. He has recorded two commercial albums on the Golden Crest label, and is active as an arranger and composer for all forms of wind band organizations. He has served as guest conductor and clinician in over 30 states and Canada, and is active in the College Band Directors National Association, MENC, Pi Kappa Lambda, ASCAP, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Kappa Kappa Psi, NBA, Phi Beta Mu, and WASBE.
