Allan McMurray

Allan McMurray is Professor of Conducting, Director of Bands, Conductor of the Wind Ensemble and the Symphonic Band, and Chair of the Conducting Faculty at the University of Colorado. Prior to this position, he was on the faculty of the University of Michigan. He has also been on the faculties of Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville, the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, the Interlochen Arts Academy, and was Artist-in-Residence at the University of Missouri-Kansas City.

Since Professor McMurray's arrival in 1978, the University of Colorado Bands have distinguished themselves with performances at major conferences and conventions including Manchester, England, Nemo Nu Sato and Hamamatsu, Japan and Boulder, Colorado. He has premiered numerous works for wind ensemble and has earned praise from such notable composers as George Crumb, John Harbison, Michael Colgrass, Steven Stucky, Joseph Schwantner, and Warren Benson for his expressive interpretations of their works.

Considered an authority on conducting pedagogy and wind repertoire, Professor McMurray has been a guest conductor, lecturer, and clinician throughout the United States and 13 foreign countries. He is the host for the CBDNA National Conducting Symposium in Boulder and founded the conductor's intern program during the summer Arrowbear Music Camp in California. Former conducting students now hold high school, college, and professional conducting positions throughout North America.

Professor McMurray received a BME degree from California State University in Long Beach and graduate degrees in trumpet performance and conducting from the University of Wisconsin. He has done postgraduate study in trumpet and conducting at the Advanced Institute of the Arts in Montreux, Switzerland. He is the President of the College Band Directors National Association, on the Board of Directors for the John Philip Sousa Foundation, and a member of numerous professional organizations including the American Bandmasters Association. In addition, he is a recipient of the Bohumil Makovsky Award for Outstanding College Band Directors from the national band fraternity, Kappa Kappa Psi.

Richard L. Blatti

Richard L. Blatti currently serves The Ohio State University as Associate Professor of Conducting and Associate Director of Bands. In addition to his duties as music director and conductor of the OSU Symphonic Band, he supervises all aspects of the undergraduate conducting curricula for the School of Music and assists with the graduate wind conducting program as well as the administration of the university band department. Under his direction, the OSU Concert Band completed a 1994 compact disc recording on the Delos label of the music of Alan Hovhaness, featuring trombonist Christian Lindberg and the conductor Keith Brion. Additional performances of OSU bands under his baton include the 1993 CBDNA national conference, the Professional Conference for the OMEA in 1992 and 1995, and the *Band Conductor's Art* Conducting Symposia from 1990 to present. Professor Blatti is the 1991 recipient of The Ohio State University School of Music Distinguished Teaching Award.

Mr. Blatti brings to his position a wide knowledge of both traditional and contemporary wind literature. Prior to his appointment at OSU, he was Associate Professor of Music at Albion College in Michigan, where he served as Director of Instrumental Music, conducting the College Orchestra, the Wind Ensemble, "The British Eighth," and the Jazz Ensemble. Under his direction, the Albion College Wind Ensemble achieved critical acclaim for performances across the country and in Canada.

An avid proponent of the community band movement, Mr. Blatti is the Music Director and Conductor of the Heisey Wind Ensemble, a well-established adult community band affiliated with Denison University. In addition, he has been invited to guest conduct and teach at numerous university campuses, school music programs, and summer camps throughout the United States, Europe, and Australia.

Mr. Blatti earned both the BME and MM degrees from Northwestern University, and is completing the DMA degree in conducting at Michigan State University. He is in constant demand as a guest conductor, clinician, adjudicator, author, and lecturer.
