John Phillip Sousa

Terry Austin

Terry Austin is Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music at Virginia Commonwealth University where he oversees all aspects of the band program and teaches courses in conducting and music education. He joined the faculty of VCU after having held a similar position at the University of Missouri - St. Louis. He previously taught high school and middle school bands in Indiana and Ohio. Dr. Austin also founded and conducts the Greater Richmond Youth Wind Ensemble, a very select high school band that is currently in its sixth season.

Dr. Austin holds a Bachelor of Music Education from Indiana University, a Master of Arts in Music Education from the University of Hawaii and a Doctor of Philosophy in Music Education from the University of Wisconsin - Madison. He is an active guest conductor, elinician, and adjudicator and is published in several journals including the CBDNA (College Band Directors National Association) Journal, BD Guide, Young BD Guide, Instrumentalist, Dialogue in Instrumental Music Education, The National Band Association Journal, The Indiana Musicator, The Missouri Journal of Research in Music Education, and VMEA (Virginia Music Educators Association) Notes. Austin is chairman of the score selection panel for the National Band Association - William D. Revelli Memorial Band Composition Contest, a member of the International Jury for the Louis and Virginia Sudler International Wind Band Composition Competition, and president-elect of the Virginia Music Educators Association.

In addition, he maintains memberships in College Baud Directors National Association, Music Educators National Conference, the National Band Association, Pi Kappa Lambda, and Phi Beta Mu (the International Bandmasters' Fratemity). He is listed twice in Who's Who Among America's Teachers, a multiple recipient of the National Band Association Citation of Excellence, and is a member of the American Bandmasters Association.

John R. Locke

Since 1982, Dr. John R. Locke has served as Director of Bands, Director of Summer Music Camps, conductor of the Wind Ensemble, and conducting teacher at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro School of Music. A professor in the School of Music, he holds a Bachelor and Master of Music degrees from West Virginia University and a Doctor of Education degree >from the University of Illinois. Prior to his arrival in North Carolina, Dr. Locke held teaching positions in music at West Virginia University, Southcast Missouri State University, and the University of Illinois. He has conducted band performances throughout the country including performance at the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C., Lincoln Center in New York City and at the national conventions of MENC, CBDNA and ABA. In 1987 and 1992, the UNCG Wind Ensemble earned critical acclaim from The Washington Post newspaper following concert performances in the nation's capital. In addition, Dr. Locke has guest conducted the U.S. Air Force Band, the U.S. Army Field Band, the U.S. Navy Band and the Dallas Wind Symphony, as well as numerous college and university bands.

Dr. Locke has served as Editor of The North Carolina Music Educator and is Past-President of North Carolina Music Educators Association, an affiliate of MENC representing 2,200 music teachers in North Carolina. He has published articles on band and wind ensemble literature in the Journal of Band Research and in Winds Quarterly. In 1989, Dr. Locke was selected for membership in the prestigious American Bandmasters Association. He has been a recipient of the National Band Association Citation of Excellence on three occasions. In 1994, Dr. Locke was awarded the Bandmaster of the Year Award by the Phi Beta Mu International Bandmaster Fraternity, presented at the Mid-West International Band and Orchestra Clinic. In 1999, Dr. Locke became President of the Southern Division of the College Band Directors National Association and was also elected to the Board of Directors of the American Bandmasters Association. In March 1999, the UNCG Wind Ensemble performed at the American Bandmasters Association Convention in Cocoa Beach, Florida. He is a frequent lecturer and consultant on college and university campuses on music student recruitment and summer camps. At UNCG, he is the founder and the director of the Summer Music Camp program, now the largest college summer music camp in America enrolling over 1,700 students annually. In addition, Dr. Locke is the founder and director of the Carolina Band Festival and Conductors Conference held in February each year. Since 1977, he has administered summer music camps for over 33,000 students. He is in constant demand as a guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator for band festivals throughout the United States and Canada.
