Clarksville: Chambers, Ovid G. "Bud" Jr., 90, died peacefully with family by his side on Sunday, April 10, 2016 at Westminster Retirement Village.

He was born February 25, 1926, in New Castle, IN to the late Ovid Sr. and Marie Chambers.
